Loose tea selection

Earl Grey

This blend uses the finest Keemun from China's Anhui Province and Darjeeling, "the Champagne of Teas", from India, infused with the finest quality pure natural Bergamot oil which is a citrus, orange-like fruit. It was Earl Grey who popularised this tea by serving it to his guests when he was Prime Minister in the 1830s.

Assam

Assam is in the East part of India, in the valley of the River Brahmaputra. Assam teas such as this are rich and full-flavoured with plenty of colour and a distinct malty character, with some sweetness, ideal for drinking with milk throughout the day and have enough flavour and richness to accompany food well.

Darjeeling

Darjeeling is the world capital of quality tea. This region, high in the foothills of the Indian Himalayas, produces low yields and exceptional quality. Darjeeling is called the Champagne of tea and always has a toasty, muscatel flavour. This tea will take milk if desired.

Lapsang Osprey

Once drunk, Lapsang is never forgotten. Its distinctly smoky, tarry character is something you either love or hate, and opinion is sharply divided! Osprey is the highest quality of Lapsang, this is a black China tea (though originally Oolong was used). Our tea comes from the lower hills of the Fujian Province in the East of China.

Herbal tea selection

Peppermint

*Peppermint is prepared from the dried leaves of the tree *Agonis flexuosai*, a cross between water mint and spearmint. It can be found wild throughout Europe and Asia and is now increasingly grown to meet demand in England.*

Lemongrass

A native of Southeast Asia, lemongrass was introduced to the English palate with the growing popularity of Thai cuisine. It has a delicate Meyer lemon taste, with slight hint of sweet ginger, and very aromatic floral fragrance. Smooth and fragrant when steeped as a simple cup of tea

Camomile and Lavender

Camomile and Lavender herbal tea is a luxurious and delicious blend. A mixture of daisy-like whole Camomile flowers from Egypt, with smooth, rich, soft, relaxing Lavender flowers from Spain. Each flavour underlines and accentuates the other and they make an ideal match.
